



## Adopt-a-Day Challenge

Our Adopt-a-Day Challenge gives your group of 6 to 10 individuals a great opportunity to team build while assisting us with building safe, decent, and affordable homes for low-income working families. Partnering with Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg is the perfect way to celebrate the milestones in your organization's history or to build stronger employee teams, all the while effectively promoting your community responsibility through association with our internationally recognized brand.

Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg's Adopt-a-Day Challenge is a fundraising program and requires a minimum donation of \$200 per person. Habitat has build opportunities from April to October, but ideally we need help after our main build - on Tuesday through Thursday, August 11-28. Tasks at this time can include but are not limited to: completing siding, fascia, soffits, basement framing and building sheds. There are only 36 Adopt-a-Day spots, and they sell quickly. If you are interested in the Adopt-a-Day Challenge 2009 season, please don't wait to book your spot.

Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg provides your Adopt-a-Day team with refreshments and food for the day as well as Habitat t-shirts. First aid supplies are available onsite. Your team will need to take a short safety course prior to their Adopt-a-Day and this can be done at your location or at the Habitat offices. Adopt-a-Day participants are required to wear CSA steel toed shoes/boots and hard hats at all time on the construction site. Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg has a small lending library of approved steel toed shoes/boots, however we recommend that participants provide their own footwear. Hard hats are provided by Habitat. We also recommend that each of your team members bring a hammer, utility knife, carpenter's pencil, apron or tool belt, tape measure, CSA approved safety glasses, and work gloves. Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg's ReStore sells well priced tool belts including all these items with proceeds going to Habitat.

Habitat for Humanity Winnipeg's Adopt-a-Day Challenge is great for team moral, corporate and community responsibility, and for low-income working families in Winnipeg and our community. Your company/organization/group will also benefit from a listing on our website, inclusion in our annual report, a tax receipt, and the use of our logo for one year. In addition, you will receive a framed picture of your team and an invitation to the house dedication where the keys are official given to the new homeowners!
