# Together, we build a better future.

Habitat for Humanity builds, retrofits and finances safe, affordable homes locally and around the world, working alongside the individuals and families who buy them.

We bring people together to build homes, strengthen communities, and create opportunity. At Habitat Manitoba, we are committed to affordable housing and to fostering equity, inclusion, and diversity in all that we do. Our work creates space for individuals to contribute fully to a collective effort that transforms lives.

The social and economic benefits of Habitat's homeownership program reach far beyond individual families. They bolster Canada's economy and productivity into the future. In a five-year period from 2019-2023, the total economic footprint of Habitat's work to build and rehabilitate homes was **\$311 million**, generating nearly **\$40 million** in tax revenues.

## After moving into their Habitat home, families see improvements in:



### Health

**73%** of families say their physical health is better

**79%** of families say their mental health is better



### Education

**41%** of adults start or complete additional education

**50%** of families' children are doing better in school



### Financial security

**51%** of families say their financial security is better



### Employment

**44%** of adults improve their employment



### Community Involvement

**50%** of families take part in more community events

**50%** of families volunteer more
